Ordering

Telephone orders can be made during business hours.

Shipment

Orders are usually shipped in two to three weeks. Shipment is made by UPS or economy air freight unless otherwise specified. Shipping arrangements must be made when the order is placed.

You will be contacted when your order is ready for shipment. An estimate of shipping costs can be provided at that time. Price guidelines do not include shipping.

Shipping damage must be noted in the presence of the carrier. It is the buyer's responsibility to make the claim and recover losses from the carrier. Contact us immediately if there is shipping damage so replacement products can be made. Replacement of shipping-damaged products will be expedited.

Prices

A price guideline is included with this catalog. Prices are subject to cliange without notice. Please verify pricing when you place your order.

The price guideline lots you accurately estimate pricing. The price guideline does not consider manufacturing difficulty, therefore actual prices vary slightly. A minimum order of \$50 is required for most items.

Prices do not include pre-finishing of the product. Price disputes will be handled promptly. "Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this contract or any breach thereof, shall be settled in accordance with the arbitration tribunal of the Better flusiness flureau of Seattle."

Payment

Visa, Mastercard, and Discover Cards are velicone. On all credit card orders the account number, expiration date; mailing address, and phone numbers are required. Phone credit card. orders may require written verification with a signature.

Cortified checks and money orders are prefetred if payment is sent. Personal checks are welcome, but they may delay delivery.

Orders are usually accepted on a C.O.D. basis.

Commercial accounts are available. A comprehensive credit history is required. Allow two weeks for the establishment of an account.

A 50-percent deposit is required before manufacturing will begin

Warranty

Arvid's Woods buys only high quality raw materials. High quality materials, combined with the care taken in manufacturing, results in high quality products.

If you are not satisfied with our product, please call immediately. All orders are checked for quality. If you receive a defective product, it can be returned for implacement. Please remember that shipping damage is the responsibility of the carrier. Check orders carefully for shipping damage in the presence of the carrier.

Back Orders

Arvid's Woods stocks over 400 moulding profiles. If you order a product that is not in stock, your order will be ready approximately two weeks from the date the deposit is received. Allow three weeks for reproductions and four weeks for custom orders.

Rush Service

Expedited service is available at an additional charge. A \$50.00 up-charge per item expedited, plus a ten percent surcharge, will guarantee five day turn-around.

Returns

A 15 percent restocking charge will be made for stocked items. Returned products must be accompanied by the invoice Returns must be made within 30 days. All returned items must be unaltered and in good condition.

Unstricked items, reproductions, and custom products earmed be returned. On stocked products, quantities in excess of normally stocked quantities cannot be returned.

Reproduction Mouldings

Arvid's Woods reproduces moulding profiles to customer specifications. Send a sample or a scale drawing of the moulding you want made.

Reproduction costs are based on the size of the moulding and the number of knives required to make it.

Knives cost \$10.00 per knife inch with a minimum of \$75.00 per laife. Mouldings usually require one or two knives.

Accessories and Custom Work

Arvid's Woods also manufactures fireplace mantels, pediments, comets, screen doors, and many other products. We would appreciate the opportunity to replicate or create products unavailable through other sources. See the accessory index on page 86.



THE MOULDING PRIMER

Mouldings can transform your home. Mouldings can be contemporary or reflect the past. Much of the unique beauty of historical homes is attributable to the use of mouldings.

Why Wouldings

The application of moulding is an investment that can dramatically change the appearance of a home. Mouldings can help turn a home into a show-place. Homes that lack architectural details can be easily transformed by using mouldings. Whether the "style" is colonial, victorian, traditional, or contemporary mouldings let you achieve the desired style.

The "moulding system"

Planning is an important part of any building or remodeling project. Once you have decided that moulding will play a role in a home's appearance, take time to select a "moulding system". A moulding system should include all the moulding types you may want to use. Choose compatible casings, baseboards, chair rails, ceiling crowns, panel trims, etc. Once the selection process is complete, you can proceed with the project, confident that the results you want will be achieved.

The moulding system needs to be selected in the planning stages of the project. When moulding selection is left until the end of a building project, it tends to get short-changed for budgetary reasons or due to project "burnout". Moulding plays a major role in the final appearance of a home. Do not overlook this important design element.

Moulding Quality

Wood is a natural material and grain and color changes should be expected. In stain quality mouldings, knots will be small and tight. Arvid's Woods reserves the right to make repairs of both natural or milling defects. When mouldings are made from Tinished lumber (fir. hemlock, pine, et al.), the net dimensions of the moulding may be reduced in both thickness and width if a length of moulding can be straightened using normal installation techniques, it is considered good quality. Unless specified, Arvid's Woods reserves the right of choice of wood type for paint grade mouldings.

Installation of Moulding

The installation of moulding can be done by a professional carpenter or by the "do-il-yourselfer". A qualified finish carpenter can install a full complement of mouldings (casing, base, chair rail, and cailing crown) in a typical home in several days.

The equipment necessary to install moulding includes a tape measure, mitre box and saw, hammer, and a nail set. With a little practice, the "do-it-yourselfers" can successfully install mouldings in their home.

Selection of Moulding

You do not need a lot of experience or expertise to do a good job of selecting mouldings. Arvid's Woods' sales staff will be happy to assist you in the selection of a moulding system. You can get ideas from decorating magazines, architectural books, "street of dreams" tours, and visiting historic homes and buildings.

Arvid's Woods' sales staff can give you the basic guidelines relating to styles, sizes and uses, but use your imagination to create unique and beautiful moulding combinations of your own. Many designers and architects make extensive use of moulding in their designs.


BASE BOARDS


Baseboards are used to finish the base of a wall.
